Addoni

A Hebrew name for God; Often used instead of Jehovah

Alas

A word used to express sadness or concern about someone or something

Beacon

A signal used for guidance, such as a lighthouse

Continuously

Constantly and repeatedly

Devoted

Having dedicated oneself

Dragon

Usually a reference in Revelation referring to Satan (See example: Revelation 12)

Filthiness

A condition of being dirty

Gog

A nation that is mentioned alongside Magog whose exact identity is unknown (See Ezekiel 38:1-39:24)

Haunt

To visit a place or someone as a ghost; To constantly remind someone of an event, usually negative; To happen often and spontaneously

Hittite

Group of descendants from Canaan (son of Ham); Lived amongst Israelites at times

Imagery

The use of language to paint a picture of something

Pitfalls

Traps; Something that poses a danger

Regret

The desire to retract a previous action or statement

Seal

Something used to sign a document using a symbol or emblem to make it law; A device used to close off certain places such as Jesus' tomb (See Matthew 27:62-66) and the scrolls (See Revelation 6); Something that secures documents

Shield

A piece of war gear that was used as an offensive weapon and to protect soldiers or at the very least make a soldier feel more safe if it was made from weaker materials such as wicker (See Ephesians 6:10-20)

Snatch

To grab quickly

Tarry

A stay to remain or stay; As in a place

Tremble

To shake; To be overcome by anxiety or fear

Volunteer

A person who works without pay willingly
