Abolish

To do away with; Put an end to; Annul: Make void

Adulterous

Having sexual relations with someone other than a spouse

Battle

A struggle; A fight between opposing armies

Beneficial

Helpful; Useful

Bowed

To bend at the waist, usually in reverence

Canaan

The land promised to the Israelites after leaving Egypt

Confident

Having a sense of trust in something, someone, or oneself

Convention

A gathering, usually of church leaders, that takes place at a set time and location

Demons

Evil non-human spirits; They are angels that were evicted from Heaven along with Satan because they rebelled against God

Empowerment

Encouragement; Something uplifting

Fool

One who shows disregard to wisdom; Often a word used in Proverbs

Pierced

Thrust into something

Ravines

Small valleys with a stream

Reap

To harvest crops

Silent

Quiet; Making little to no sound

Test

To try to tempt; To examine the strength of a person's faith

Troubled

Distressed, uneasy, or worried; Not calm or relaxed

Victory

The act of overcoming something or someone.

Whoredom

A lifestyle of promiscuity

Yahweh

The name of God given to Moses in the book of Exodus at the burning bush. (See Exodus 3-4:17) It is claimed that nobody really knows what the word sounded like since Hebrew has only consonants in its alphabet and Jewish tradition long since then has not allowed the name to be pronounced. The Hebrew letters transliterate to YHVH (sometimes the V is said to be W). This name comes from a verb with the root letters h-v-h. This verb is the same in meaning as the verb with the root letters of h-y-h, meaning to be or to exist. By declaring this as His name, He is declaring His sovereignty. The Hebrew ehyeh asher ehyeh means I will be whatever I will be.

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Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

"Ehyeh" is the first person form of h-v-h in the future tense in English (I will be). Since Hebrew names are Hebrew words, it is likely the real name of God is Yihveh, the third person future tense of h-v-h.

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
