Audacity

The arrogance or boldness to go outside the norm to do something, usually in the negative sense

Bestowed

To have given something as a gift

Betrayal

Act of "backstabbing" or to do something against a person's expectation.

Bishop

A position of authority in churches; From a Greek word meaning "Overseer"

Bondservant

A slave; A laborer who is forced to work without payment

Christ

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

Creation

Something that which was made; usually refers to the material world constructed by God.

Defile

To greatly disrespect a special place or thing or another person;
To desecrate

To dedicate

Doubt

Unbelief; Skepticism; To question something

Designated figures of authority in government

Overflow

To be filled with great measure.

Pagan

A person who practices a polytheistic religion; A word used to describe things related to a polytheistic religion

Reaction

A response to something happening

Sustain

To keep something operating or living

Verdict

A judgment made in court
