Appointed

Designated, Arranged

Awake

Not sleeping and alert

Baptism

A public act signifying a person's identification with Christ's death and resurrection. A public acknowledgment of one's faith to and commitment to Christ.

Christ

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

Co-Heirs

A person who inherits something along with another person

Confidence

Trust; Strong belief

Creditor

A person who is owed money

Diligence

Constant attention; Haste

Forbidden

Not allowed; Prohibited

Heresy

False teaching, contrary to the accepted truth.

Humbled

To have lost arrogance; Having humility

Intervene

To come between people to resolve a conflict or fix a problem

Predestination

Maintains that God is the one who decides who will be saved (See Romans 9:16) and that it is not up to the desire of the person. (See John 1:13) God is the one who ordains the Christian into forgiveness. (See Acts 13:48) Also maintains God knew in advance those who would accept His gift of salvation. (See Romans 8:29-30)

Ransom

A demand made in exchange for something worthy.

Shame

An emotional reaction to guilt

Sinful

Wrong; Evil; Ungodly

Sleep

To be inactive and dormant

Soon

Quickly or immediately

Spear

W weapon made from a long shaft with a sharp point at one end; A common strategy in ancient warfare was for soldiers to form a wall of shields while holding spears forward to fight off oncoming charges

Tendency

A proneness or trend
