Baal

A god/idol the Israelites worshiped instead of God, especially during the days of King Ahaz (contemporary of Elijah)

Confident

Having a sense of trust in something, someone, or oneself

Defiled

Desecrated; Greatly dishonored

Desirable

Worthy of having or wanting; Pleasing, excellent, or fine

Goads

Something that causes pain by pricking such as a thorn; Something that is used to urge someone or an animal to do something

Goliath

A giant and soldier from the Philistine city of Gath who was killed by David with a sling and five smooth stones after being hit in the forehead; David fought Goliath while none of the Israelite soldiers dared to, refusing armor, and decapitated him after his defeat (See 1 Samuel 17)

Graves

Places where the dead are laid to rest

Ignorant

Not knowing or understanding

Jubilee

Year of Jubilee was to occur every fifty years. Slaves were to be set free, all properties returned to original owners, and people were to recognized that the whole land was God's and He was lending it to them.

Judah

One of the 12 tribes of Israel; The man who the tribe of Judah came from

Plague

A deadly illness or disease that strikes an area; Moses with Aaron speaking performed ten plagues before Pharaoh (See Exodus 7-11)

Redemption

The act of taking back what is rightfully yours.

Reserved

Set aside for a certain person or group

Revival

A renewal and restoration of what once was; Usually refers to a return of a person or group of people to Christian faith

Sabbath

A special day set aside by God for people to rest and do no work; The seventh day of the week (See Exodus 20:8-11)

Samaritan

A race of people in the New Testament who lived between Galilee and Judea in Samaria; A people group who were despised by the Jews.
