Beatitudes

A portion of Jesus' sermon on the mount describing attributes of a Christ-follower (Matthew 5), Usually begins with "blessed are the ..."

Bloodshed

Violence that causes blood to be shed

Burial

The practice of placing a person in a tomb or grave as part of a funeral

Compel

To force or manipulate someone into doing something; To drive someone to take a certain course of action

Crucify

To nail a person to a cross or stake; The Romans did this to the worst criminals and made sure they would be seen to make an open example of those who rebelled against Rome

Destiny

Something a person is meant to accomplish or a place, physically or in life, that a person is meant to reach; God's plan for a person's life

Disguised

To have concealed the identity of someone or something

Emerald

A green gemstone

A charge given to an audience based on a principle

Flint

A type of stone often used for knives by the ancient Israelites in circumcision

Follow

To be a disciple of someone

Generosity

A willingness to give to others

Implore

To ask for something sincerely

Instruct

To teach; To pass on knowledge to another person or group

Quench

To relieve, stop, or extinguish

Shalom

Peace, wholeness, or completeness; Literally means "To destroy the authority that establishes chaos"

Sustain

To keep something operating or living

Tribes

Jacob (also called Israel) had 12 sons and all the descendants of the 12 sons are called tribes.
