## Words Used And Their Definitions

### **Adopted**

To have the rights of a child governed by someone other than his or her biological parents

### **Bondservant**

A slave; A laborer who is forced to work without payment

### **Conquering**

Defeating; Overpowering; Taking over

### **Continue**

To go on

### **Crucify**

To nail a person to a cross or stake; The Romans did this to the worst criminals and made sure they would be seen to make an open example of those who rebelled against Rome

### **Dragon**

Usually a reference in Revelation referring to Satan (See example: Revelation 12)

### **Dread**

To fear or be uneasy; Fear or uneasiness

### **Encounter**

To meet or come across something or someone; the experience of coming across or meeting something or someone

### **Finished**

Completed; Accomplished

### **Generations**

All people born at about the same time

## Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

### **Heir**

The next in line to a throne or in equal to a ruler or king.  
Christians are often referred to this with Jesus in God's riches.

### **Humiliation**

Embarrassment; Putting someone to shame; Making a person humble

### **Mock**

To ridicule or make fun of someone; To poke fun at someone or something

### **Perjurer**

A person who does not do what he / she vowed, made an oath to do or swears falsely

### **Portion**

A person's share in something; Destiny; Lot in life

### **Prayer**

Communication with God.

### **Promptly**

Immediately

### **Reveal**

To show something that was unknown or unnoticed

### **Wander**

Moving around or traveling with no set goal or destination; The Israelites wandered in the desert for forty years (See Numbers 14:26-35)

### **Yield**

To hold back. Can also refer to the potential of something.

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
